Holy Week is sacred ground. It invites us to walk closely with Jesus not just toward the **empty tomb**, but through the **painful path that leads to it**. And yet, if we're honest, many of us want to jump straight to Sunday morning. We love the sound of victory. We long for the hallelujahs. But we mustn't rush past the silence of Saturday or the suffering of Friday.

Jesus didn't bypass the cross to get to the resurrection and neither should we. The betrayal in the garden, the trial before Pilate, the weeping at the foot of the cross, **all of it matters**. Every moment reveals the depth of Christ's love and the weight of the salvation He offers us.

This Holy Week, I invite you to feel the whole story. Let yourself sit with the discomfort of grief and the ache of waiting. Don't be numb to it or skip it. **Feel it.** Because in those moments of pain and sorrow, God meets us with a love that holds nothing back.

Easter is coming but let it come on its own time. First, we remember. First, we weep. And in doing so, we better understand the **glory that breaks through the grave**.

God loves you more than words can say and that love is written in every page of the Passion story.

1 cup semisweet chocolate chips 1/2 cup butter, melted

1 cup pecans

1/2 cup all-purpose flour

1/2 cup sugar

1/2 cup brown sugar

2 eggs

1 teaspoon vanilla

Pinch of salt

Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

Prepare 9 in. pie crust. Put chips in bowl, pour melted butter over them. & stir until chips are mostly melted. Add remaining ingredients, stirring well. Pour into pie crust.

Bake for 30-40 min. until filling forms a smooth brown crust and begins to pull away from crust.

Filling will be wet in center but will form up as it cools. Wait one hour before slicing.
